2019 Rules & Regulations

Mission, Goals and Vision

Festival Fridays Creates the opportunity for folks to buy and sell West Virginia grown or produced products, while providing entertainment and creating an inviting atmosphere for all Citizens to enjoy. Increases access to fresh, West Virginia produced, nourishing and safe foods for citizens. Encourages, supports and promotes the entrepreneurial efforts of West Virginia independent growers, artisans and residents, seeking to sell their products directly to the public. Creates an opportunity for people to meet, eat and share stories, recipes and knowledge.

2019 Dates & Times of *Festival Fridays*: 5:00-8:30 pm each Friday evening

MAY 31st **JUNE** 7th – 14th – 21st – 28th **JULY** 5th – 12th – 19th – 26th **AUGUST** 2nd – 9th – 16th – 23rd

Participation: The Festival is open to all artisans, growers, harvesters, bakers, non-profit organizations and makers of prepared foods (hereafter, "vendors").

- The fee will be \$25 per vendor for the entire 13-week festival
- The fee is for one (1) booth only, approximately 10 feet wide
- No space reservations: *1st Come... 1st Choice* of space any time after 4:00 pm

(Several covered spaces on the West end of the walkway are reserved for Farmer's Market Vendors and three covered spaces next to the West side of the center stage are reserved for Create Buckhannon)

(Note: do not arrive before 4:00 pm as the City utilizes the parking area until that time).

- If you are selling the same merchandise as the previous year, then you do not have to submit a vendor application. However, you will need to notify us by email/mail and pay your fees.

Products permitted for sale:

1. **Vegetables/Fruits/Herbs** grown by the farmer/grower
2. **Fresh Baked Goods** Made by the producer-vendor
3. **Cheeses** All dairy products must be pasteurized and **in** accordance with state and county health codes.
4. **Cut flowers** which were grown on the vendor's own farm or greenhouse
5. **Eggs** which are from the producer-vendor's own poultry
6. **Jams, honey, maple syrup, and other value-added products** which *are* freshly made by the vendor, using seasonal ingredients from their farm or another West Virginia farm. Processing must comply with local and state health codes.
7. **Soaps/Candles/Body Care products** which are hand-crafted by the vendor
8. **Meat** from livestock raised by the producer-vendor and which has been processed at a federally-inspected facility. Fish/Shellfish which are raised by the vendor may be sold, provided they are processed and sold according to state and county health guidelines
9. **Artwork** – Created by the artist and family friendly
10. **Crafts, Furniture & Accessories** – Handcrafted by the vendor in West Virginia with limited pre-manufactured materials
11. **Wools, Pelts and Fleeces** – Handcrafted by the vendor in West Virginia with limited pre-manufactured materials
12. **Potted plants, shrubs, or annual bedding plants** which are grown in West Virginia from seeds or cuttings
13. **Other – for approval by committee (submit photographs and full description)**

NOTE: In keeping with the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources Document F-7, (formerly F-45) the following specialty items can be sold at Festival Markets without being processed in certified processing kitchens, provided that they were made in sanitary conditions using recommended hygiene and safety guidelines: Non-dietary jams, jellies and preserves; apple butter; molasses; sorghum; undiluted honey and undiluted maple syrup; dehydrated fruits and vegetables; vinegars (plain, herb or flavored); cakes, cookies, or fruit pies; yeast bread, nut or fruit breads.

Note that cream, custard, or meringue pies, cakes, or cookies are prohibited unless refrigerated.

- **External regulations:** Vendors are responsible for compliance with applicable City, County, State and Federal regulations that may be applicable for all products offer for sale.
- **Festival signage:** Vendors must display a sign identifying the name of their farm or business. Producer-Vendors should have signs, boards, tags, or labels listing prices of every item for sale.
- **Clean up:** Vendors must clean up the area around their vehicles and sales area before leaving. Vendors must place all rubbish, containers, waste and trimmings in a designated waste receptacle.
- **Market Behavior:** Vendors are entrepreneurs with a common stake in creating a vibrant Festival Marketplace for all citizens to enjoy. Members of the Festival Committee will assist in finding a resolution to all issues that may arise.

Friends of the Festival: Non-vendor members may join in to help support Festival Fridays by becoming a **Friend of the Festival** for \$100 per year.
